



# LINGO AND OTHER HELPFUL INFORMATION

- ◆ **Class A Uniform**– Dress Uniform (Blue shirts Tigers thru Bears, Tan Shirts Webelos thru Boy Scouts)
- ◆ **Class B Uniform**– Pack t-shirts and hoodies (provided by Pack 168)
- ◆ **Den Meeting**– Meeting where individual dens meet (Tiger=1st Grade, Wolf=2nd Grade, Bear=3rd Grade, Webelos=4th Grade, Arrow of Light= 5th Grade)
- ◆ **Pack Meeting**– Meeting where entire Pack meets
- ◆ **Advancement** – The progression that moves the Cub Scouts from rank to rank.
- ◆ **Adventure** – Adventures are a group of activities around a specific topic. Each rank completes six required adventures and two elective adventures to earn their badge of rank.
- ◆ **Buddy System** – The buddy system is used to help Cub Scouts look out for each other. At Cub Scout events, especially outdoor activities, kids should find a partner.
- ◆ **Pinewood Derby** – Cub Scout racing event. With help from their parents, Cub Scouts design and build a race car using a kit that contains a block of wood, plastic wheels, and axles made from nails.
- ◆ **Den Leader** – The Den Leader (usually a parent) coordinates meetings and activities centered around the Cub Scout Adventures.
- ◆ **Cubmaster**- Cubmasters help plan and carry out the Cub Scout program in his or her pack. They support and motivate den leaders and parents.
